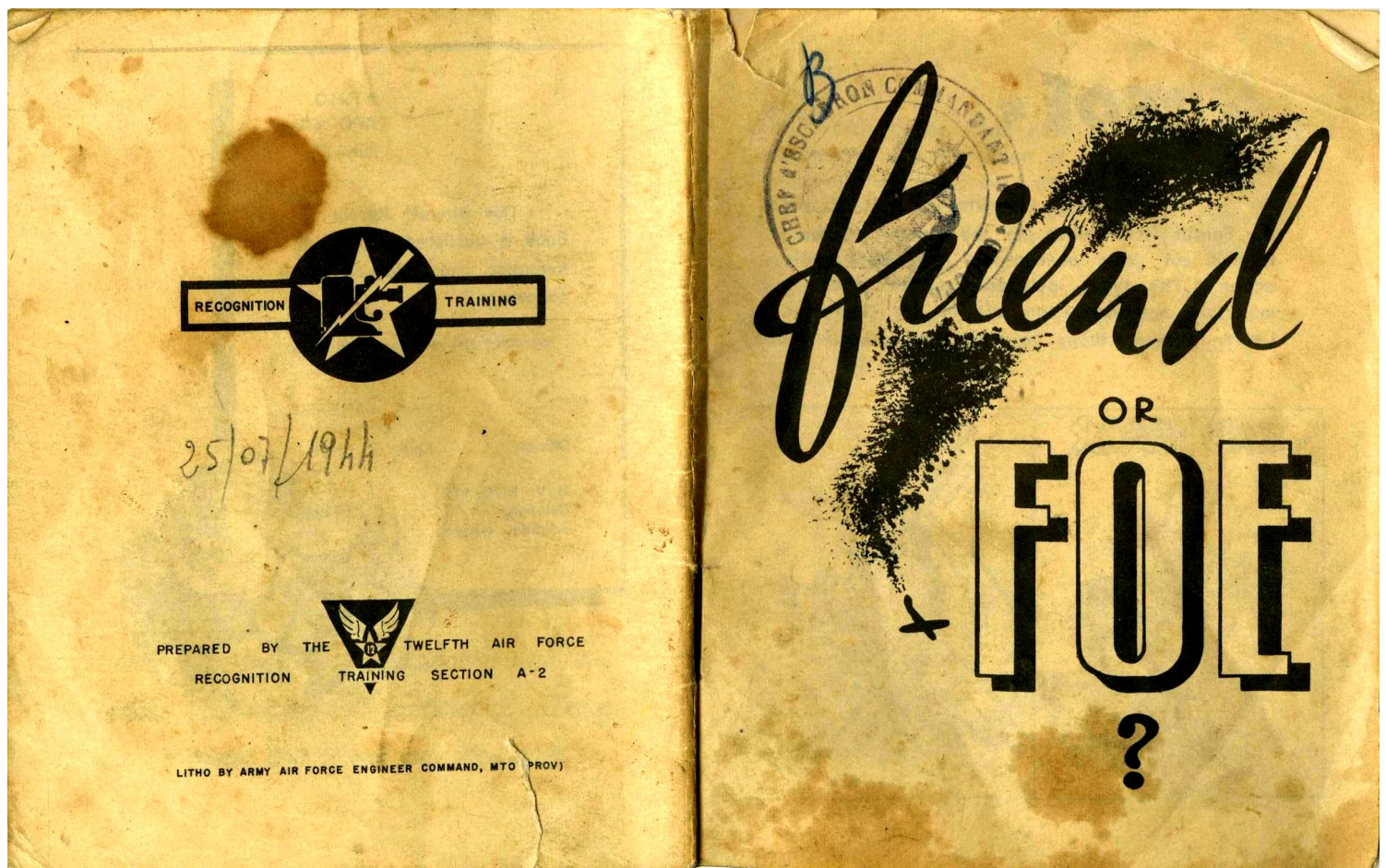

## THE SAD SACK

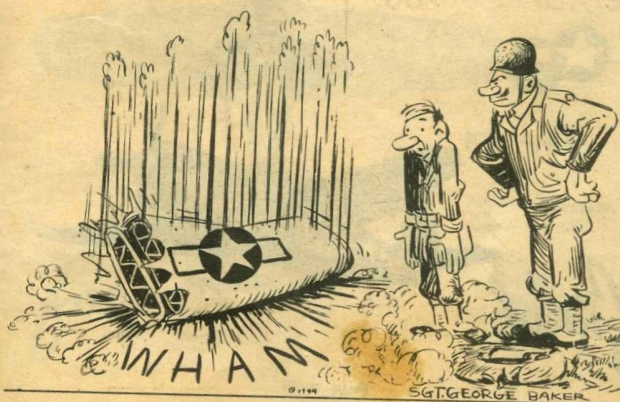


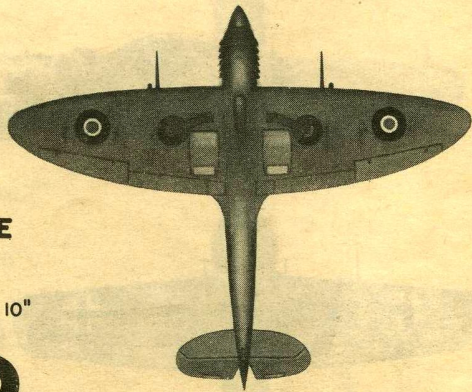
